

# BEAVERS BEND GROUP CAMPS

## GROUP CAMP #1

The meeting hall was built by the Civilian Conservation Corps in 1940 and the grounds are the original CCC Camp.

Group Camp #1 has a stocked commercial kitchen with large pots, pans, and cooking utensils. We have 4 large ovens, 2 large griddles, and 12 burner tops. The camp has a walk-in cooler for refrigeration and 2 small chest freezers. We have ice at the camp for purchase.

The hall has tables and chairs for approximately 125 people. There is a fireplace at one end of the hall (you will need to bring your own firewood). The hall has central air conditioning and heat. Electricity is metered and we charge per KW hour.

There are 12 cabins, 6 on each side of the hall. All cabins have heat and air. Each cabin has 6 bunk beds (12 total beds). You will need to bring bedding. The AC/Heat in the cabins is metered and we charge per KW hour.

The camp has a group bath house with 5 showers, 5 toilets, and 3 sinks on the men's and women's side of the facility.

There are electrical hookups (30 amp breakers) for 10 RVs. An outside stage is available for your use as well. There is a charge for RV's

The area between the campground and river is available for tent camping and campfires.

We provide trash bags (for our trash cans) and toilet paper. The camp has brooms, mops and buckets. You will need to bring cleaning supplies, dish towels, etc....

## GROUP CAMP #2

Group Camp #2 was built in the late 60's when the Broken Bow Dam was built and the River Bend area of Beavers Bend State Park was developed.

Group Camp #2 has a stocked commercial kitchen with large pots, pans, and cooking utensils. We have 2 large ovens, a griddle, and 6 burner tops. The camp has a walk-in cooler for refrigeration and 2 small chest freezers. There is a heated serving line for food service. We have ice at the camp for purchase.

The hall has tables and chairs for approximately 100 people. The hall has central heat and air conditioning. The air conditioning is metered and we charge per KW hour.

There is a bedroom with 4 twin beds and private bathroom and shower off the kitchen area.

The camp has 10 cabins with Air/Heat window units that are metered and we charge per KW hour.

The cabins are equipped with bunk beds. One cabin has a bathroom (toilet and sink) and sleeps 14, 10 downstairs and four in the loft. The other nine sleep 16, 4 downstairs and 4 in the loft. You need to bring your own bedding.

The bath house has 5 toilets, 6 sinks, and 5 showers on both the men's and women's side of the facility.

There are 5 RV pads with electrical (30 & 50 amp breaker) and water hookups. There is a charge for RV's.
